**Ethics**

**Science and technology**

Minimum of three or four semester hours. Completion of course in science which includes a laboratory experience (e.g., biology, chemistry, physics, physical geography, astronomy).


**Visual and performing arts**

Minimum of two or three semester hours in a participatory or non-participatory arts courses (e.g., ARTF, ARTH, CRAF, PAPR, THEA, APPM, PHTO).


**Humanities and social sciences and interdependence**

Minimum of nine semester hours. Three hours in humanities (e.g., literature, RELS, HIST, PHIL, foreign language) plus three hours in American, European or Non-Western culture plus three hours in social sciences (e.g., PSYC, SOCY, SOCS, ECON, POLI, AFAM, ANTH, GEOG, WMNS, SLWK). One of the three courses must have an international or global emphasis.
