Undergraduate Program Travel Awards 2009-10

Prize:

\$300 awards to be used for student travel to any professional meeting. Funds may be used for preparation, presentation, registration, airfare, or other costs associated with attendance at the meeting.

Eligibility:

1. Enrolled as a full-time student in the undergraduate forensic science program as of August 2009.
2. Successful completion of 54 semester hours, either from VCU or by acceptable transfer, by the end of the summer semester 2009.
3. Priority will be given to students who are giving an oral presentation or a poster presentation at the professional meeting.
4. Applicants will be ranked and assigned point values for selection based on their GPA and their involvement in forensic science department activities. In the event of a tie, preference will be given to graduating seniors.

Application Requirements:

1. A letter of intent explaining why the applicant should be awarded a travel award.
2. The applicant's resume or CV.
3. Abstract of submitted presentation (if applicable).
4. The student will give a presentation to the FSSC and other students upon return.
