

Rozanne Garrett Epps Undergraduate Scholarship Application Form

The Rozanne Garrett Epps Undergraduate Scholarship was established by friends and Epps family members in honor of Mrs. Epps, the former director of VCU Evening and Off-campus Studies, who retired in 1986. The scholarship is intended to assist undergraduate students returning to school after being in the workforce. Juniors and seniors from all undergraduate majors are invited to apply. Award criteria are indicated below:

- Student must be a degree-seeking junior or senior returning to school after being in the workforce.
- Student must possess a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher. (Copy of unofficial transcript is required.)
- Student must submit a 500-word essay and two letters of references from VCU faculty members. Essay must address career, educational and/or life goals, and other characteristics distinguishing you as a potential recipient of this award. Briefly describe your present and past employment experiences. The essay must be attached to this application with your name clearly printed at the top of the page. (Please ask faculty to cite the title of this scholarship, Rozanne G. Epps Scholarship, in their letters of recommendation.)

Application materials must be submitted to the Office of the Dean in a single package containing original and two copies of each: application form, essay, unofficial transcript, and two reference letters by Feb. 1 at 5 p.m.
